Farm History

In 1888, Emma Day, a Glenelg resident wanted some adventure, went west and taught school in the territory of Oklahoma. There she met and married Asa Sharp, homesteaded and had 5 children. By 1903, she was homesick, missed Maryland hams and wanted to say goodbye to the prairie winds. The Sharps moved to Glenelg and built a home, farmed Knollwood on Sharp Road and eventually had 3 more children. Lawton Sharp (1903-1986) and Frances Sharp (1912-2007) continued the tradition by dairy farming and raising 5 children. In 1969, Chuck Sharp, upon being discharged from the army, took over the farm. The dairy herd was sold and Chuck transitioned to beef, hay and produce. In 1980, Denise joined the farm and greenhouses and educational tours were added. In 1985, the Sharps were blessed with the opportunity to farm at Waterford Farm, and in 1988 were blessed again at the birth of their son, Alan. Ever since, the Sharp family and staff have opened the farm in the spring and fall for your family to enjoy the farm and the tradition of agriculture in Howard County.

DIRECTIONS TO SHARP'S AT WATERFORD FARM

From Columbia

From Rt. 29, 6.5 miles west on Rt. 108, then go right on Rt. 32. Go 5.4 miles then left on Burntwood Rd. Go 2.7 miles then left on Rt. 97, go 2.7 miles then make a right on Jennings Chapel Rd. Drive 1.1 miles and Waterford Farm will be on your right.

From Baltimore

From 695, 17 miles west on I-70 then go south on Rt. 97 (towards Olney). Go 6.2 miles then go right on Jennings Chapel Rd. Drive 1.1 miles and Waterford Farm will be on your right.

From Washington D.C.

North on Rt. 97 (Georgia Ave.) 7.3 miles past Rt. 108 Olney then go left on Jennings Chapel Rd. Drive 1.1 miles and Waterford farm will be on your right.
